- Customs-Trade New Partnership Against Terrorism (C-TPAT) statistics were provided at recent Customs Trade Symposium in Washington on Nov. 3<sup>rd</sup>. There are 10,079 certified C-TPAT participants; 1,106 validations have occurred; and 2,484 validations are in process. While not mentioned at MANDATORY AES DELAY the Conference, the validation reject rate continues approximately 20%.

## **ENFORCEMENT**

As reported in the Journal of Commerce, Robert Allen, CBP Regulatory Audit Field Director. stated that commercial enforcement efforts are being increased.
